RED'S PLEDGE. "Honor America Day" celebration was held in Washington D.C., co-chaired by Billy Graham and Bob Hope, entertainer Red Skelton "wowed" the crowd of more than 350,000 with his famous recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. This is what he said:

"I remember this one teacher. To me, he was the greatest. He had such wisdom. We were all reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, and he walked over...Mr Lasswell was his name—and he said:

"I've been listening to you boys and girls recite the Pledge of Allegiance and it seems to me it is becoming monotonous to you. May I recite it to you, and explain the meaning of each word?

I—me, an individual, a committee of one.

Pledge—dedicate all my worldly goods to give willingly, without self-pity.

Allegiance—my love and devotion.

To the Flag—our standard, Old Glory, a symbol of freedom. Wherever she waves there is respect because your loyalty has given her dignity that shouts freedom is everybody's job.

Of the United—that means we have all come together.

States—individual, free communities that have united into 48 great States, united in pride and dignity and a common purpose, and that's love for country.

Of America—one America. Our America.

And to the Republic—a state in which sovereign power is invested in representatives chosen by the people to govern. And government is the people, and it's from the people to the leaders, not from the leaders to the people.

For which it stands:

One Nation—meaning, so blessed by God.

Indivisible—incapable of being divided.

With Liberty—which is freedom and the right to live one's own life without threats or fear of some sort of retaliation.

And Justice—the principle of dealing fairly with others, of equality under law.

For all—which means it's as much yours as it is mine.

"Since I was a small boy," concluded Red Skelton, "two states have been added to our country, two stars have been added to our flag and two words have been added to the Pledge of Allegiance; 'under God.' Wouldn't it be a pity if someone said, 'That's a prayer' and that would be eliminated from schools, too?"

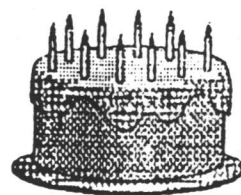
