7. Not putting paper in wastebaskets

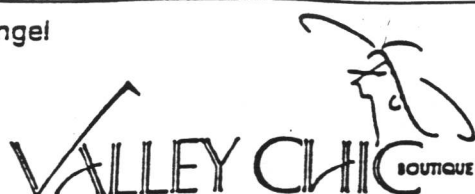
The top seventeen (17) problems in 1982 (not ranked in any specific order):
