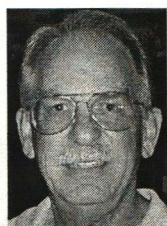
Additional new business that took place involved the swearing-in of our new IFA, Carson Valley Chapter #72 member, Dawn Gibbons. Congratulations Dawn
