## From the Secretary-Treasurer

At the last meeting we had a very interesting speaker, Captain John Milby, who is the Investigations Division Commander of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office. He gave us an overview of the Secret Witness Program and presented statistics that showed how successful this program is. There were 7 armed robberies, 70 burglaries, 50 narcotic, 1 prison escape cases, among others, brought through to conviction and imprisonment of the perpetrators thanks to the Secret Witness tips.

Captain Milby emphasized the point that any tip received by the Douglas County Sheriff's Office is held in strictest confidence. He assured us that any tip information is first corroborated by separate sources before it is used to capture, try, and sentence those found guilty. When asked if there has ever been a case where a person who provided a tip was required to testify in court, the answer was, no.

As you will recall, I did not have the latest bottom line figure for our account at our meeting. As of today, November 17, 2012, we are solvent with \$5232.06 in the bank.




Our next regular meeting will be January 17, 2013 at the Casino Fandango in Carson City.
