She also explained how the money needed to landscape Phase I of this freeway project was obtained through grants, and donations. GROW's 12 years of dedicated work resulted in a beautifully landscaped freeway, with native plants, water efficient landscaping and historic vignettes representing Carson City's History. This landscaping project employed hundreds of local citizens, involved Carson area companies, and the cost to us the taxpayer was very little!! Without their efforts the freeway through Carson City could have been an unsightly concrete structure. Mary and the members of GROW are the epitome of the 'volunteer' spirit!! 
From the Secretary-Treasurer

disappointed that my Pittsburgh Steelers fell short.


