as 2nd VP, who served us all well in the past for two years with her impressive list of guest speakers.

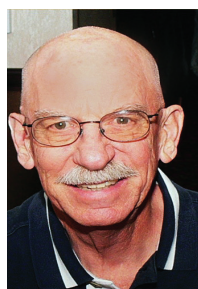
