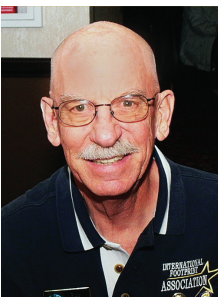
the training and dedication this job entails.

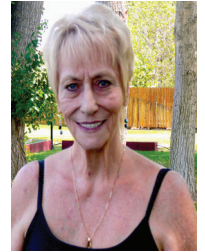

We are approaching the holiday season, and I wish you all well and joy. See you at the Nugget on November the 20th.

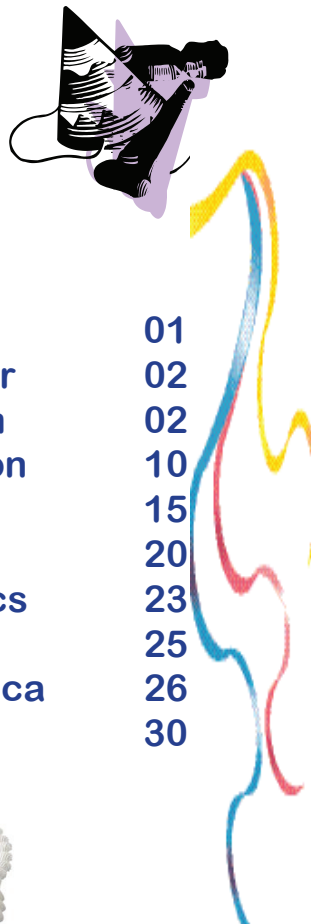

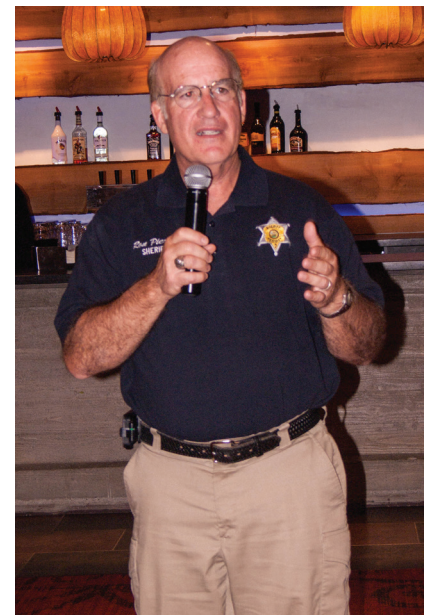
