Annual Nomination of Officers/Directors

The annual Nomination/Election cycle begins in February. Per our chapter Bylaws, the cycle goes like this:

February	President appoints a Nominating Committee
March & April	Committee reports to the membership at dinner meetings
April	Election of officers and directors
July	Those elected will take office on July 1

One-year terms will be nominated and elected for President, First Vice President (Venues), Second Vice President (Programs), Secretary, Treasurer, Sgt-at-Arms, and Grand Director. Three Year Director terms will be nominated and elected for any number of 3 Year Directors.

The Immediate Past President on the Board is automatic. Last year's two elected Three-Year Directors (Bayan Lewis and Dave Chieruzzi) will automatically become Two Year Directors without need for nomination and election. Members interested in running for office are urged to contact the Nominating Committee.

The reason we nominate and elect so far in advance of July 1 is that the Grand Chapter requires chapters to hold their chapter elections prior to May 1 each year and report the results to the Grand Chapter by May 10 each year. In order to meet those deadlines, we hold our elections at our April meeting.


