This month's meeting will be held on Thursday, January 21 at the Casino Fandango!

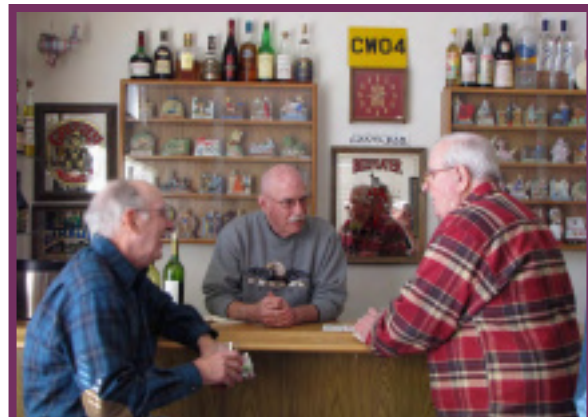

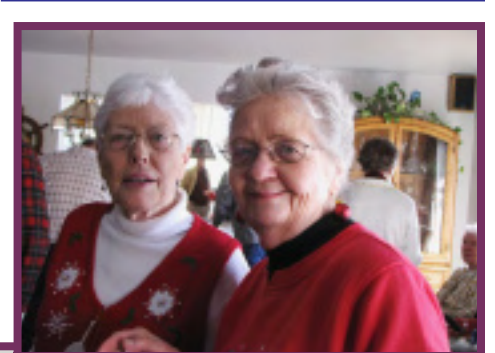

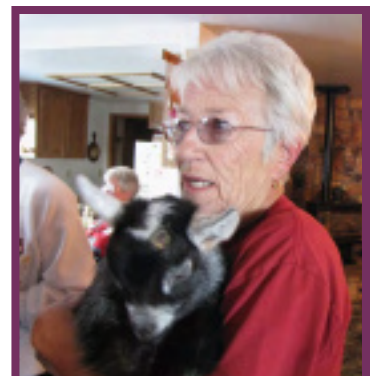
