The annual dues renewal period is almost upon us. I expect to send out the dues notices sometime during late May or early June. Annual dues remain at \$24 per year.

At the April meeting, the membership voted to approve the Board recommendation to fund some equipment for the Douglas County Sheriff's Office. First, two laptop computers for use by DCSO's Commercial Vehicle Enforcement and Interdiction program were needed to track multiple offenders with the overall benefit of making our streets and highways safer. Second, some additional funds were needed to purchase a digital audio-visual system to replace the "old fashioned" overhead projector for training and courtroom use. Total funding provided was \$2000. As usual, the funding the chapter provides is for programs or projects that are either not funded or underfunded by the county.

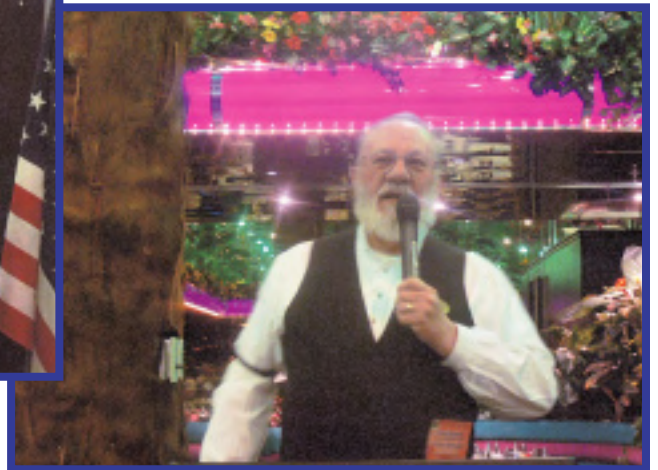
Hello from the 2nd Vice President
