Students who couldn't talk to their parents or teachers would often put their total trust in these school officers. The officers soon became a source of unofficial counseling and helped untold kids out of problems they

had no idea how to escape from.

So congratulations to our Deputy! He performs a job that is really special and more than pulls his weight in our community. Thanks to Douglas County for recognizing the importance of staffing the Resource Officer position with such a quality officer who indeed makes a difference.

Hello All,

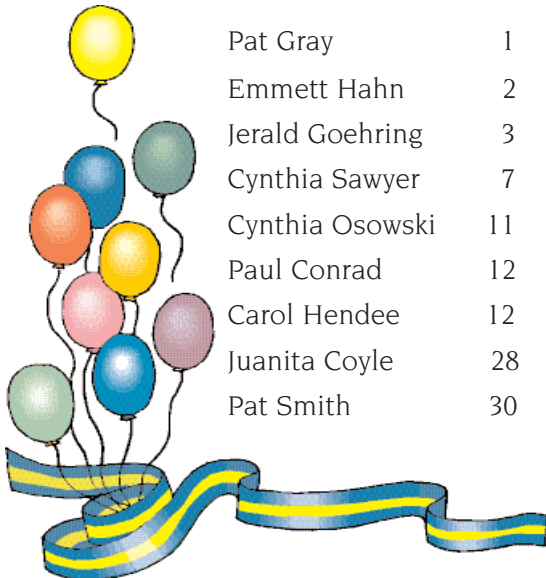
