

The International Footprint Association currently consists of 24 chapters within 4 districts. District 1 represents members in Washington State, district 2 represents members in northern California and Nevada, district 3 represents members in southern California, and district 4 represents members in Utah, Colorado and Nebraska.

Each district has a District Governor whose duties shall be (1) to coordinate the activities of the district's chapters, (2) to act as the liaison between chapters and the Grand Chapter, (3) promote and develop new chapters within the district, (4) provide publicity of district activities, and (5) aid the chapters in any way possible. The District Governor for District 2 is Archie Marcum, a member of Chapter 72.
