Membership Update ***By Ray Hoyt***

As I write this column with about a week to go in FY21, we are in the middle of membership renewal season. Our current membership strength is 95 regular and 2 associate members. Four of the 95 are intending to drop their memberships, two of which are moving out of state. Of the remaining 91 regular members, FY22 dues have been received from 65 of them. It would sure be nice if most or all of the remaining 26 would send in their dues before they become delinquent.

As for associate memberships, the Grand Chapter Bylaws define them as follows:

Section 8.7.1 ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP. Any member of any Subordinate Chapter in good standing in their home Chapter may become an Associate Member of another Subordinate Chapter, or Chapters, by paying not more than the same contribution as the other members of said Chapter, excluding the national per capita tax. All Associate Membership cards shall be furnished by the Grand Secretary-Treasurer. Provided, however, that said Associate Member shall have all the rights and privileges as the other members of said Chapter, as long as they remain in good standing in their home Chapter. But, they shall not have voting rights in said Chapter, nor be counted as an active member for delegate count purposes, nor be allowed to be a delegate or officer of said Chapter. Further, said Chapter shall not be assessed per capita tax for said Associate Member or members.

Chapter 72 currently has two associate members:

Past Grand President Jerry Redford, member of Peninsula Chapter #35

Past Grand President Dan Hanlon, member of North Bay Chapter #15

Both of them are long-time members, and have supported our chapter for many years.
